Jukka has a D.Sc. degree in forest planning and economics from University of Joensuu (UEF), where he has been also working from 2014. Before moving back to UEF he had 20 years experience in teaching, research and administration at Oulu University of Applied Sciences, and as a practical forest manager in a Forest Centre. His previous duties include positions of School director and manager of Silvicultural Measures and Quality. He has been a leader of several domestic and international RD-projects related to collaborative management of natural resources.
